POLICY, STRATEGY AND LEADERSHIP COURSE (PSLC)

OVERVIEW

The National Institute's Policy, Strategy and Leadership Course (PSLC) which debuted in 2008, is a four-week course designed to provide deep conceptual framework for middle-to-top-level policy initiators and implementers who are not only policy input providers of their respective organizations, but on whose skills and resourcefulness most organizations leverage to manage human and material resources for the attainment of corporate goals.

The input of this level of officers is key to policy formulation just as their buy-in is important for policy implementation. Therefore, their analytical skills need to be sharpened to enable them perform effectively as functional and strategic business unit (SBU) managers.

Participants on this Course will be taken through intensive studies in policy formulation, strategy development, resource deployment and effective leadership. This highly interactive course runs quarterly and is delivered in three modules - the Policy Module, the Strategy Module and the Leadership and Management Module.

COURSE OBJECTIVE

Equip middle-to-top level executives with a deep understanding of the frameworks necessary for policy formulation and implementation, as well as strategic competencies which are critical for effective leadership.

STRATEGY COURSE FOR COMMAND RESPONSIBILITY, CYBER SECURITY AND INTELLIGENCE MANAGEMENT (SCCR/CS-IM)

OVERVIEW

The Strategy Course for Command Responsibility, Cyber-Security and Intelligence Management (SCCR), is a triple-module course designed to expose participants to key and fundamental aspects of command responsibility, cyber-security and intelligence management within the context of an effective national security architecture. The Course which will draw from key concepts and fundamentals of policy, strategy and leadership, will be delivered through in-depth and participatory lecture, brainstorming and case-study sessions aimed at illustrating and simulating key aspects of these modules as well as their implications for improved organizational performance, operational security insight and intelligence-driven decision-making processes that have far-reaching impacts in the field or theatre of engagement.

The Course will be facilitated by highly experienced military and civilian Resource Persons of repute and extensive experience, as well as cybersecurity and intelligence management experts and professionals.

OBJECTIVES

At the end of the course, participants will be equipped to:

- Lead their respective commands effectively, and inspire enhanced operational performance for improved national security;
- Design and drive an effective intelligence gathering and dissemination ecosystem;
- Devise best methods to leverage protective Cyber-Security systems that would help enhance the nation's security architecture

The Workshop will comprise interactive sessions which will comprise experiential sharing and learning, practical working syndicates, groups and individual activities, plenary discussions and technical sessions based on designed activities intended to help participants better manage the post-retirement stages of their lives.
